Dear FOIA Officer,

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552.

I request: (1) any interagency agreement, memorandum of understanding,

statement of work, task order, or written communication between the U.S.

Election Assistance Commission and the National Design Studio (or the

Executive Office of the President) concerning vote.gov — or any preview,

replacement, or redesign of vote.gov — dated August 1, 2025 through

December 31, 2025; and (2) any record identifying who directed or initiated

the vote.gov preview project and when it was initiated. Basis for the date

range: the first public TLS certificate for the vote.gov preview site in

the National Design Studio preview system issued September 8, 2025 (public

certificate-transparency logs), and NDS itself was established August 21,

2025 (E.O. 14338) — both before January 1, 2026, where my prior request

(EAC 26-0064, answered "no records" July 9, 2026) began. If no responsive

records exist for the 2025 window either, I request written confirmation of

that fact.

If no responsive records exist, I request written confirmation of that

fact, including a description of the search conducted.

To minimize processing burden, I am not requesting classified information,

sensitive security or law-enforcement methodologies, or private personal

information unrelated to official government business. This request seeks

records of official government activity only.

Fee waiver: I request a waiver of all fees under 5 U.S.C. §

552(a)(4)(A)(iii). Disclosure meets each factor of the public-interest

standard: (1) the subject specifically concerns the identifiable government

operations, programs, or investigations described in this request; (2)

disclosure is meaningfully informative about those operations and how they

are conducted; (3) it will contribute to public understanding at large, not

merely my own, because I will make the records available to the general

public; and (4) it is likely to contribute significantly to public

understanding of how federal authority is exercised and how government

programs and investigations are authorized and conducted. This request is

not in my commercial interest and is not made for a commercial purpose. If

a fee waiver is denied, please notify me before incurring any costs over

\$25.

Expedited processing: I request expedited processing under 5 U.S.C. §

552(a)(6)(E) on two grounds. (1) There is an urgency to inform the public

about actual or alleged federal government activity, and I am a person

primarily engaged in disseminating information: I publish the government

records I obtain through a public records docket available to the general

public. (2) This request concerns a matter of widespread and exceptional

media interest in which there exist possible questions about the

government's integrity that affect public confidence. I certify that the

foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

If any portion of a responsive record is withheld, please cite the specific

FOIA exemption claimed and release all reasonably segregable non-exempt

portions, as required by 5 U.S.C. § 552(b).

Please provide responsive records in electronic format (searchable PDF or

days provided by 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(A)(i).
